From the south

M621, M1 and M62 motorways follow the signs to Leeds city centre and train station, along Neville Street towards City Square. Pass under the railway bridge and at the traffic lights, take a left into the slip road in front of the hotel.

From the north

Take any main A road into Leeds and then follow signs for the train station which leads you around the city centre loop road. At the top of Neville Street, at the traffic lights, take a left into the slip road in front of The Queens.
